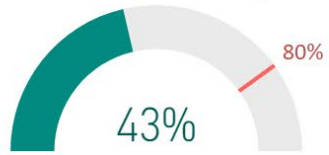

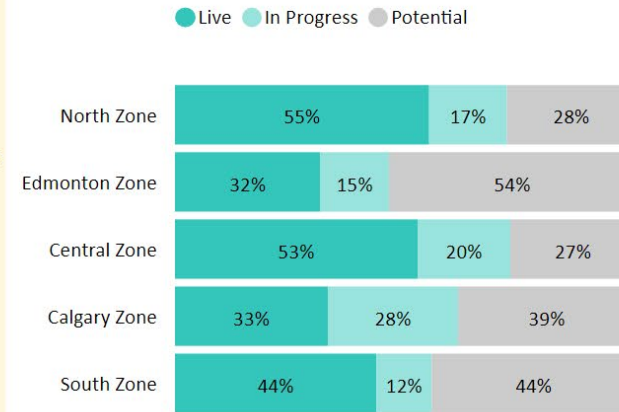

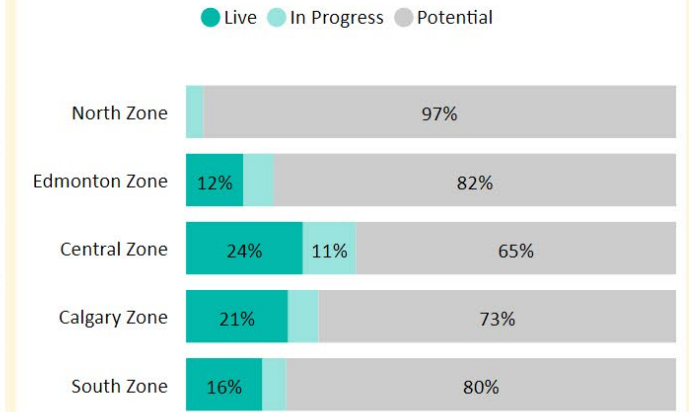

All family physicians live on CII / CPAR are eligible to receive a Confirmed Patient List (CPL) panel report from the HQCA

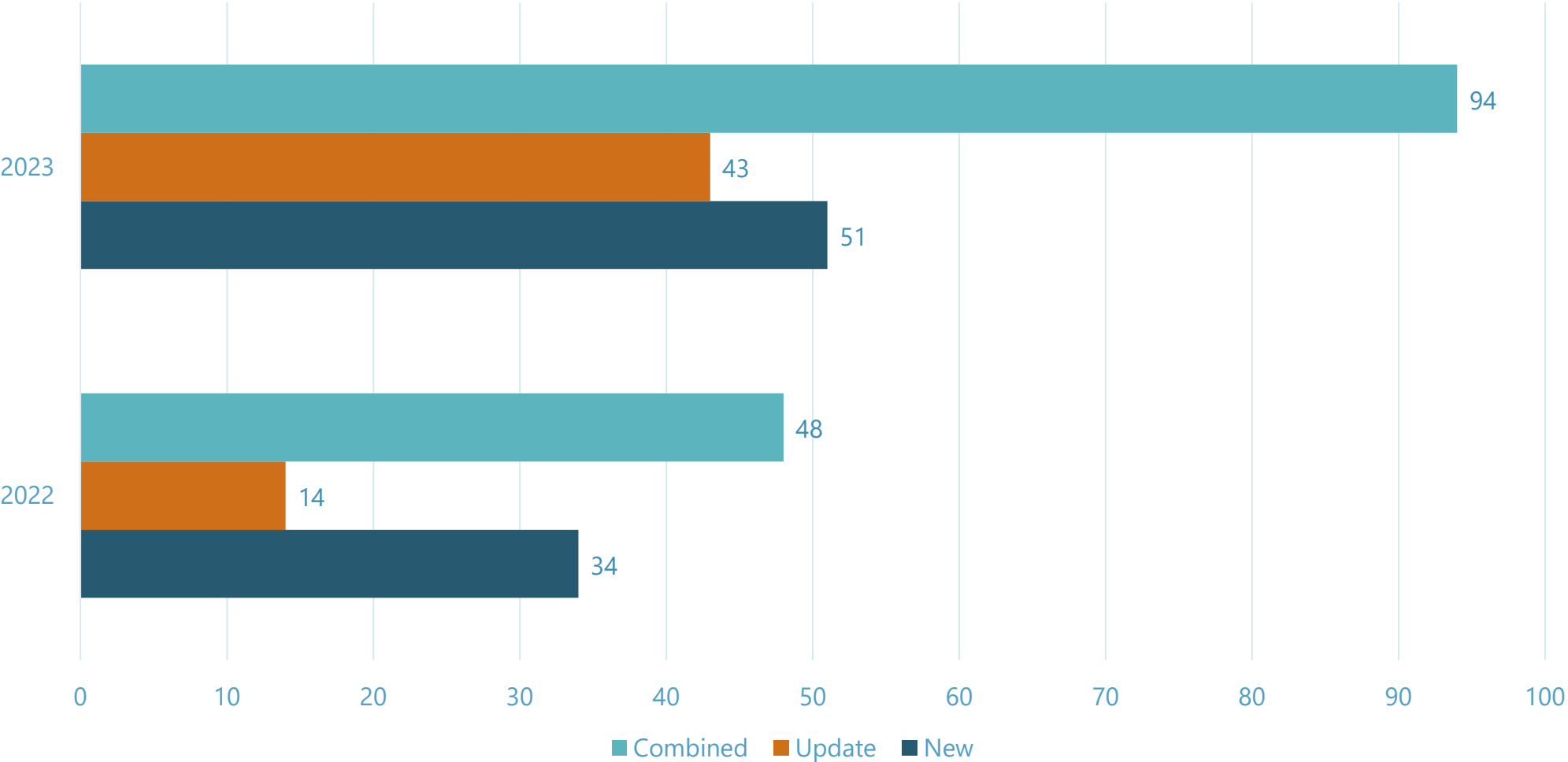

The disclaimer on eHealth forms is changing

- Ensure you are pulling the new documents from the website
 - Alberta Health provides necessary information to the Alberta Medical Association to administer financial support under the IM/IT Physician Practice Support Program.
- New primary care CoP forms available on website

Top 5 reasons why forms are rejected



1) Unsigned Access Administrator form

2) WDFA instead of Facility ID

3) Invalid PracID

4) Faxing Panel Request form without an Access Administrator form and vice versa

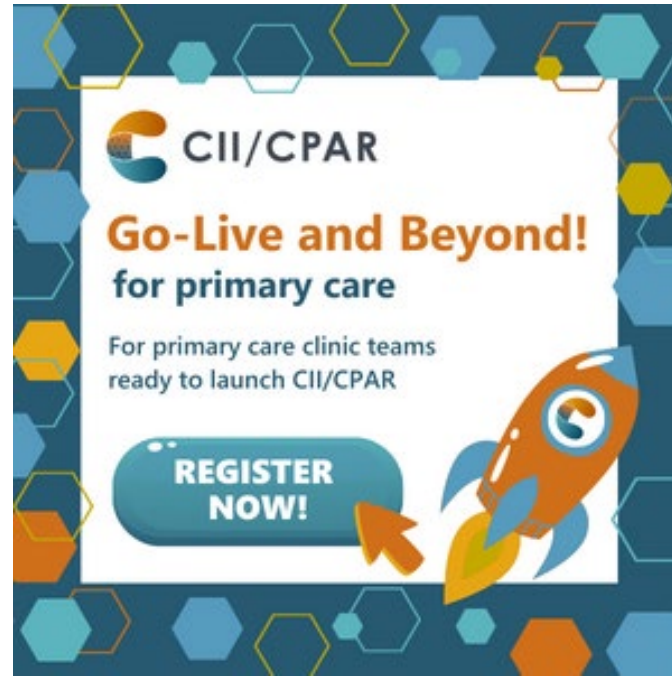
5) Incomplete remote access section
