3 - Board Governance	28 mins	 Describe the three-basic functions of a Board. Demonstrate understanding of Board fiduciary responsibilities. Describe the guiding principles of governance. Introduce the key responsibilities of the Board.
4 - Board Meeting Types and Board Member Roles	20 mins	 Distinguish the types of meetings required of Boards. Explain typical PCN Board roles. Distinguish roles of Board members versus those of the Executive Director. Develop positive joint governance and stakeholder relationships.
5 - Making Good Decisions	11 mins	 Distinguish between three types of decisions that may come before a board. Execute informed decisions consistent with your fiduciary obligations. Describe the role of the Chair in decision making.

Describe the purpose and content of a Code of Conduct and a Code of Ethics. Learn to identify conflict of interest situations in your PCN. Apply Insights Discovery Model TM to optimize communication.
